Proceed with Caution!

- COVID-19 case rates, hospitalizations, and deaths are falling, but still remain very high. <u>Vaccinations are occurring as quickly as</u> <u>supplies allow, but most people in our community are still not</u> <u>vaccinated!</u>

Allowed indoors at REDUCED capacity:



- Restaurants: MAX 25% capacity or 100 people, whichever is fewer
- Retail stores: MAX 50% capacity
- Gyms and fitness centers: MAX 10% capacity
- Movie theaters: MAX 25% capacity or 100 people, whichever is fewer
- Zoos, museums, and aquariums: MAX 25% capacity

Key to fewer restrictions is following public health measures.

- Counties can move to a less restrictive tier as COVID transmission goes down and testing goes up.
- Stay diligent. Wear a mask, keep your distance, and get vaccinated when it's your turn.
